The following is additional information for the Criminology major:

- The major requires a 2.0 or higher GPA.
 - The major also has a “D” rule for major grade requirement.
 - Students majoring in Criminology are expected to complete their major coursework in a timely fashion. Students who receive a total of three (3) D and/or F grades in Criminology major coursework will no longer be eligible to continue in the Criminology major and will be required to change their major outside the Department of Criminology. Grade forgiveness will not exclude a D or F grade from counting for this rule.
 - Major Residency Requirement: A minimum of 30 credit hours of major course work must be taken in residence at the University of South Florida. Therefore, no more than 6 credit hours of transfer work (two courses) will be accepted to meet major requirements.
 - Major Internship Opportunities: The department provides all students with the opportunity to engage in an internship with a federal, state, or local criminal justice related agency within one of the surrounding counties.
